Fill in online - admission form for the academic Year :-2020-2021

All students should note that they should fill up their admission form online. For this, they will have to log on to "www.ldsonawanecollege.com"

In order to fill up the above mentioned admission form a student will need only, his/her Student ID Number., which has been mentioned on his/her identity card.

Once a student follows the procedure given below, student can fill online admission form & submit the same online.

Students can use online payment mode (Net Banking / Credit Card) for paying their fees for the academic year 2020-2021 at the time of admission.

PLEASE READ ALL THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY, THEN & THEN ONLY START TO FILL IN THE ONLINE ADMISSION FORM FOR THE YEAR: 2020 – 2021.

The detailed instructions for filling up this online form are as follows.

Step 1

Students are supposed to go to "www.ldsonawanecollege.com" web site, on Home Page there is a link for Online Admission 2020-2021.

Step 2

Now, Online Login Form is displayed.

The students are supposed to Login by entering the Student ID mentioned on their Identity Card, in the window shown on screen. The Password is the same as the UID Number.

Step 3

On first login, the system will ask the user to change the password.

The password would be necessary for students for future communication in the Online Portal during their course in the College. Therefore, the students should remember it for future login. Do not share your Login & Password with others.

Step 4 – Admission Form Part I

On the login, student will find his/her personal details and next class of admission which are displayed on the screen. Check for its correctness and if any discrepancy is found, contact college office after completing the admission process. The student is not allowed to do any change at this step. If your Aadhaar number is not listed only then enter the correct Aadhaar Number.

Step 5 – Admission Form Part - 1 Notification

If any student is from any of the reserved caste category then he / she would be guided to a notification, which the student has to read carefully and click on it saying, "**I have understood and agreed**".

Step 6 – Admission Form Part - 2

If there is no change in address and mobile number, student can skip this step. If there is any change, the student is supposed to enter his/her complete new address with city pin code after entering the Student Mobile Number & Guardian Mobile Number (Please enter the correct mobile numbers). For railway concession a student has to mention nearby railway station & also mentioned voter list details.

Step 7 – Admission Form Part – 3

Subjects offered by the student in the previous class will be carried forward to the next class automatically. Student cannot make any change here.

Step 8 – Admission Form Part – 4

For XII Admission, the student has to enter the marks obtained in the XI class which is available online on the college website and for S.Y. & T.Y. admission the student has to enter the marks obtained in XII class.

Step 9 – Admission Form Part – 5

Please fill in Parent's / Guardian's information carefully and correctly. In case the Parent / Guardian has retired or is a house wife then, please mention residential address in the service / business address column provided.

After this step, student has to pay the admission fees (Full Fees / 1st Term Installment Fees) online as per their class and category. After payment is successfully done the student can submit the admission form online. There is no need to take printout for college purpose. Student can take the printout for their personal reference.

If student has paid the fees online and system shows "unsuccessful payment message" then please do not pay fees again. First wait for 24 Hours and then Login again in the system and click on Refresh Payment. Even after refresh payment is still showing unsuccessful, in that case, the student should contact the college office.

Please note that confirmation of admission is strictly as per the discretion of the Principal.
