

ABSTRACT:-With the coronavirus pandemic confining people within the bounds of their homes on and off since March last year, the fitness industry also saw a major slump. Gyms and other fitness centres were seen to be one of the places where the virus would spread quickly, likely due to shared machines, towels, a lot of shared space, and the heavy breathing that came along with fitness, and so, the avenues to go out and exercise were shut off, at least for some time. While this was enough for fitness lovers to take up exercising from home. According to a report by mobile data and analytics provider App Annie, 2020 saw about 71,000 new fitness and health apps being launched, which was a 13% increase over 2019. Moreover, according to an article published on the World Economic Forum website, there was a 46% increase in downloads of health and fitness apps across the world. A significant finding of the survey details the future shape of a post-pandemic reality. The survey highlights how consumers have adopted digital fitness solutions to counter the physical restrictions posed by the pandemic.

The extended lockdown drove a massive surge in the demand for virtual classes for yoga (87%) and high-intensity interval training (HIIT) cardio workouts such as Zumba (72%), aerobics (67%), and Pilates (22%). Moreover, an overwhelming 84% of fitness enthusiasts tried live-streaming fitness classes at least thrice during the lockdown – marking a significant increase over the corresponding numbers in 2019, which stood at 29%. During the lockdown, 77% of Indians also tried to stay fit by combining household chores with virtual classes and DIY home workout routines.

Somewhat unsurprisingly, it was the younger audiences who led this charge in the demand for virtual fitness. Consumers between 25 and 34 years of age were the most willing to adopt digital fitness solutions, with female users (60%) being more open to virtual classes than male users (40%). Abstract:-India's horticulture sector is growing and playing a vital role in the continent's agricultural economy. India is the second largest producer of fruit and vegetables globally, but horticultural development is currently constrained by poor marketing. The gap between prices received by farmers and those paid by consumers is large, reflecting inefficient marketing arrangements. This study estimates the market costs, market margins, price spread, the producer's share of the consumer's rupee and the market efficiency of horticultural commodities under different supply chains, and suggests measures to improve marketing efficiency. The study was conducted in the states of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Punjab, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Manipur and Mizoram, covering 29 crop types. The results show that, in the case of most commodities, marketing costs, marketing margins, transport costs and labour charges adversely affect marketing efficiency, and open market price, volume of produce handled and net price received increase market efficiency or have a positive effect. The highest marketing efficiency was found in the producer-to-consumer channel. Government policies should promote direct marketing models for more efficient horticultural marketing. To promote the interest of Horticulture in India there are various subsidies which are being used by the supply chains.

This study was undertaken to determine the drainage characteristics of Iari river basin and the area of the basin is 1276 km<sup>2</sup>, central India using Geographic SInformation system(GIS) techniques was used in evaluation of linear and areal aspects of morphometric parameters. Such as stream order(Ns) stream length(Lu), bifurcation ration, (Rb), drainage density(Dd), The analysis releals that drainage pattern is dendrite and Include a sixth order stream. The stream of lower order mostly dominate the basin, the development of stream segments in the basin area is more or less affected by rainfall, the stream orders of the basin area mainly controlled by physically and lithologicaly condition of river basin area.
