Annual report (2023-24) highlights the major outcomes undertaken by IQAC:

- Initiated the process of NAAC Cycle 2 by final Submission of Self Study Report and DVV in the month of June, 2023.
- Academic calendar was designed for the academic year 2023-24.
- Various Committees were formed for smooth conduction of institutional activities.
- IQAC and Department of IT/CS jointly organized Faculty Development Programme for Administrative staff on "Basics of Computer skills" in the month of June , 2023.
- Organized Orientation program for all First year classes in the first week of August 2023.
- Programmes on Celebration of Guru Purnima, Lokmanya Tilak Jayanti, Raksha Bandhan, Gandhi Jayanti, Savitaribhai Phule Jayanti, etc were organized by different departments.
- Seminar on Women empowerment, Gender sensitization, Menstrual hygiene, etc were conducted by Women Development Cell.

- Guest lectures on Financial planning, Career guidance, competitive exams, Consumer awareness, Entrepreneurship skills, Intellectual Property Rights, Research, etc were organised for both UG and PG classes.

- The AQAR 2022-23 was finalized and submitted on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 and later the same was uploaded on college website.
- IQAC in association with Alumni association organized a Cultural festival "Milap" on 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 to strengthen alumni college relations.
- During the academic year 2023-24, 05 IQAC meetings were conducted to ensure quality assurance, academic improvement and institutional development.
