The Society made efforts to start Arts and Commerce Degree College in the academic year 2002-2003. The Government of Maharashtra granted the permission to the Society to start Laxman Devram Sonawane Degree College of Arts and Commerce on **Non-Grant Basis**" vide letter no. NCG 2002 NMV 01,2002 from the Higher and Technical Education Division, Mantralaya, Mumbai-400032 dated 15th July 2003. The University of Mumbai issued a formal permission letter to enroll the students on 22nd August, 2002, vide letter no. Aff/Recog/4031 dated 22/8/2002.

In the subsequent year, we started the Junior College of Arts, Commerce and Science. In the same year the Society was given permission to introduce three years Degree Course of Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS). During the academic year 2008-2009, we started B. Sc. in Computer Science and Information Technology. In the academic year 2011-2012, we have introduced Post –Graduate Courses; M. Com in Advanced Accountancy and M. Sc. in Information Technology. We also offer plain science subjects as Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology and Microbiology in our degree college. We started MA in Economics & History in 2013 -14. In 2019-20 we started BAF and BBI considering the increasing demand for such courses.

We are proud to inform you that in the last 19 years our College has established and developed as per the norms given by the UGC and University of Mumbai. In January, 2006 our College has been shifted to our own, new premises located in the prime location of Kalyan City. The new spacious building has been constructed on a land of 2.26 acres with a play-ground. The College Building provides all the necessary facilities as per UGC norms with spacious, well-equipped laboratories and air-conditioned laboratories for Computer Science and Information Technology.

Our spacious Library on the third floor occupies 1050 sq. ft. area with separate reading rooms for staff, boys and girls measuring 600 sq. ft area. The total book collection is 17182 with reference books, periodicals and journals. The journals include Case Folio, Global CEO, Journal of Managerial Economics, H-R Review, Journal of Applied Economics and Marketing Mastermind etc.

The Audio-Visual Room with TV, DVD Player, OHP and LCD projectors are available. 14 Newspapers are being subscribed Inflibinet N- list programme is also available to staff and students where more than 3800 e journals and 80000 e - books are available. Book Bank scheme is provided for Backward Class students.

Study tours and industrial visits are arranged for the students every year to give them practical exposure.

In 2015 in our pursuit for quality higher education we went for accreditation by NAAC and were awarded with 'B' Grade.

In 2016 on college was permanently affiliated the to the University of Mumbai and in 2017 we got ISO certification. In 2017 our college became eligible for getting grant under 2(f)/12 (B).

Our college has also got the Green and Energy Audit Certification and Environmental Audit.

Our college has been reaccredited by NAAC in the second cycle and have been again awarded with 'B' Grade in March 2024.

Documents required at the time of Admission:

Student has to submit duly filled in application form available from the General Office and it must reach the Principal within the stipulated time as notified by the College.

The following documents are to be submitted along with the Admission Form.

1. Original Mark-sheet along with two Xerox attested copies of previous qualifying examination passed by the student.



- 2. Original School Leaving Certificate along with two Xerox attested copies.
- 3. No. Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Principal of the College last attended. (Applicable to the students of other Colleges)
- 4. Original Eligible Certificate obtained from the University of Mumbai. (Applicable to the students migrating from other Universities/States)
- 5. Original Character Certificate(Applicable to the migrating from other Colleges) Students should note that all the admissions are PROVISIONAL until all the necessary Documents/Certificates are submitted in the College Office and approved by the competent authorities.
- 6. Caste Certificate
- 7. Address Proof

Admissions of all the Students admitted in the First Year Degree College will be confirmed only after their Enrollment is confirmed by the University of Mumbai.

Students from other Colleges taking admission in this College, their submitted documents will be verified from the previous College and then only their admissions will be confirmed in this College. Otherwise their admissions will be cancelled at any time during the academic year.

All the admissions will be valid only for one academic year subject to the satisfactory attendance. All the admissions require renewal for each subsequent academic year.

If student wants to cancel his/her admission, he/ she has to submit the application addressed to the Principal along with the original fee receipt.

Enrollment of First Year Students:

All the students admitted in the first year BA/B. Com/B. Sc.(Plain Science) shall apply to the Registrar, University of Mumbai for their enrollment in the prescribed application form and fee at the time of admission. The last date for submission of enrollment forms duly completed in all respects and on-line submission to the University of Mumbai will be as per the guidelines received from the University.

No Enrolment forms will be accepted by the University of Mumbai after 31^{st} December every year and admission of such students who have not submitted their forms to the University through their respective College on or before 31^{st} December will be cancelled.

The Management Council, University of Mumbai may be in exceptional circumstances; extend the last date for the submission of Enrollment Forms to the University of Mumbai.

College charges the Tuition Fees and other fees as per the Circulars received from University of Mumbai time to time. Students from Reserved Category pay fees as per the rules and regulations laid down by the University and Social Welfare Office.

Eligibility/Entry Requirement:

As per the Circular No. UG -80 of 2010 and ordinance O. 3941 dated 27th April 2010, a candidate seeking for admission in BMS Course shall have passed the HSC Examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination or Diploma in any Engineering branches with two years or three years diploma after SSC Examination conducted by the Board of Technical Education, Maharashtra State or its equivalent examination by securing minimum 45% marks for open category(in one attempt) in the respective examination and minimum of 40% for the students belonging to Reserved Category(in one attempt).

The admissions are purely on merit basis following the reservation policy as per the norms received from the Government of Maharashtra. The merit list will be prepared taking into consideration that the HSC students from Arts, Commerce and Science stream apply for BMS Course. **Separate Stream wise Merit List will be displayed on the Notice Board.**

BAF (B.Com. ACCOUNTING & FINANCE)

Eligibility for admission :

- 1) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Accounting & Finance) Degree Course shall have passed XII Std. Examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent and secure not less than 45% marks in aggregate (40% in case of reserved category) at one and the same sitting.
- 2) Every candidate shall have to register himself/herself with the University.

Duration of Course and Related Information :

- a) The course shall be a full time courses. The duration of the course shall be six Semester spreads over three years.
- b) Number of students : A batch shall consist of not more than 60 students.
- c) The course shall consist of 40 subjects.
- d) Total number of lectures per paper (subject) shall be minimum of 50 and maximum of 55 each of 50 minute duration.

- 1. A Student is allowed to keep Term for Semester-II irrespective of number of Heads of Failure in Semester-I
- 2. A Student is allowed to keep Term for Semester-III (Second Year) if he/she passes SemesterIandII.

OR

A Student who fails in not more than 2 courses of Semester –I and Semester-II taken separately (maximum 4 courses but not more than 2 courses in each Semester).

- 3. A Student is allowed to keep Term for Semester-IV irrespective of number of Heads of Failure in Semester-III. The Student has to pass each course of Semester –I and II in order to appear for Semester-IV.
- 4. A Student is allowed to keep Term for Semester-V (Third Year) if he/she passes Semester I, II, III and IV.

OR

A Student who passes the Semester-I and II and fails in not more than 2 courses of Semester –III and IV taken separately (maximum 4 courses but not more than 2 courses in each Semester).

- 5. A Student is allowed to keep Term for Semester-VI irrespective of number of Heads of Failure in Semester V. The student has to pass each course of Semester –III and IV in order to appear for Semester VI.

Examination Scheme:

(Circular No. UG/344 of 2002)

On the behalf of University of Mumbai, the College is conducting the first term and second term examinations and the entire conduct of examination is as per the guidelines received from the University time to time.

All the students admitted in the academic year have to fill up the Examination Forms in the month of August as per the schedule given by the College Examination Committee. Students those who have not filled up the Examination Forms and having less than 75% of attendance will not be allowed to appear for both the term examinations.

The first term and second term examinations are conducted at the end of respective term. These examinations carry equal marks and duration and based on syllabi/portion prescribed for the respective term.

The practical examination in any science subject will be conducted only once and before the end of second term.

Unfair Means in the Examination:

The use of Unfair Means like copying, carrying/possession of copy material in the examination hall, talking with students and directly or indirectly helping to copy in the examination hall is a malpractice.

The use of unfair means is punishable under the Maharashtra Act No. XXXI of 1982.

University has specified the rules/regulations and punishment for such students. The punishment will be either paper/subject wise or result of entire examination may be squashed or student may be debarred from the examination/college.

Student can apply for Photocopy of answer book or verification within one week of declaration of result.

(Information Technology) Course shall have passed the HSC Examination from Any Stream with Mathematics as one of the subjects of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination at one and the same sitting or any examination recognized as equivalent and should have secured not less than 45% of marks(Open Category) and not less than 40% of marks for students belonging to Reserved Category.

OR

Candidates who have passed Diploma in Computer Engineering/ Computer Science/ Computer Technology/Information Technology/ Electrical, Electronic and Applied Branches, Mechanical and Allied Branches, Civil and Allied Branches of engineering after SSC (X Standard) are also eligible for admission to the Second Year of B. Sc.(IT). However, Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other recognized government body. Eligible candidate must have secured minimum of 45% of marks for open category and 40% of marks for candidate belonging to the Reserved Category.

And

Students with post HSC-Diploma in Computer Engineering/Computer Science/Information Technology and allied branches will be eligible for direct admission in the Second Year of B. Sc. in Information Technology. However, Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other recognized government body.

All admissions will be given on the basis of merit and as per the rules and regulations received from University of Mumbai and Government of Maharashtra.

1. M. Sc. in Information Technology

Information Technology is the area of managing technology and spans wide variety of areas that include processes, <u>computer software</u>, <u>information systems</u>, <u>computer hardware</u>, <u>programming languages</u>, and data constructs. In order to meet the requirements of software professionals, programmers and the other middle level management cadre, University of Mumbai has granted permission to start M.Sc. in Information Technology Course by papers from the academic year 2011-12. The course is full-time of two years duration. After completing this course, the student can join any software industry or education field. The college is planning to provide placement services to all the post-graduate students of Information Technology. The college has a well-equipped Computer and Information Technology Laboratory with structured cabling, 75 computers connected under and a good collection of reference books.

Course Duration: 2 years-4 Semester Sanctioned Seats: 20 Admission Criterion:

1. **There will be 20 sets per batch.** All the admission will be on merit (i.e. percentage of aggregate marks secured for the qualifying examination). Reservation criterion should be followed as prescribed by government at the time of admission.

2. The student who has passed following Degree Examination is eligible for admission to M. Sc. Degree course.

B.Sc. Information Technology with minimum 45 percent marks Or B.Sc. Computer Science/BCS with minimum 45 percent marks. Or B.Sc.(Mathematics) with minimum 45 percent marks Or B.Sc.(Physics) with minimum 45 percent marks Or B.Sc.(Statistics) with minimum 45 percent marks Or B.Sc. (Electronics) with minimum 45 percent marks Or BE Degree in any branch with minimum 45 percent marks

With mathematics as one of the subject to 10+02 or its equivalent Examination.

Registration as postgraduate Student: Every candidate admitted for M.Sc. IT will have to register as the postgraduate student of University of Mumbai.

Scheme: The two year programme of M.Sc. (IT) is prescribed according to the credit system of university of Mumbai from the academic year 2012-2013. The course has been divided into four Semester. The programme has a total 16 theory papers and four in each Semester.

Eligibility Criteria for M.A. As per order No. 02237

A Candidate for being eligible for admission to the course leading to the degree of Master of Arts must have passed the examination for the degree of Bachelor of Arts (three year integrated course) of this University or the degree of bachelor of Arts (Old that is four year course) of this University or a degree of another University recognized as equivalent thereto.

Provided, however, that applications of graduates of this University in the faculty of Arts, or those who have passed the equivalent examination of another recognized University seeking admission to the M.A. degree course by papers, will be considered by the Academic Council on the merits of each individual case on the recommendation of the Head of the University Department concerned/ chairman of the Board of Studies concerned in the subject in which there is no University Department / Principal of a college where the Post-Graduate Center is granted, and in case of a student seeking admission to the course by research, on the recommendation of the Chairmen of the Committee of recognized Teachers in the subject concerned before recommending such applications, the following procedure shall be followed.

A written test consisting of 2 papers as under shall be administered in the subject in which the students desires to register for his M.A. degree.

- (i) An essay paper in the subject,
- (ií) A paper to test the student's general acquaintance with the subject.

The chance of Faculty Test required to be given by the students has been waived in case of students who desire to register with the Directorate of Distance Education.

1. Students who have passed the S.S.C. (Std. X) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent examination recognized by the Board are eligible for admission to F.Y.J.C. (Std. XI) class.

2. A student who has passed the equivalent examination other than that conducted by Maharashtra Board will be given provisional admission. All such students will have to obtain

an "Eligibility Certificate" from the Divisional Secretary, Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Mumbai and submit the same to the college office for final admission.

3. A.T.K.T. admission will be given as per the Rules of M.S.B. of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards.



Status of Admission:

1. All admissions will be treated as Provisional until all the necessary Certificate/Documents such as original mark sheets, Final Eligibility Certificate, Transfer Certificate, and School Leaving Certificate etc. are submitted and approved by the appropriate authorities.

2. No admission will be valid unless it is granted by the authority of the Principal.

3. All admissions will be valid only for one Academic Year (subject to satisfactory attendance) and will be required renewal by application in prescribed from for each subsequent year of enrolment as a student of the college.

Procedure for Cancellation of Admissions:

1. Admission will be cancelled only on receipt of an application on the prescribed form (available in the college office) together with original fee receipts.

2. The amount of caution money, Library deposit and Laboratory deposit will be refunded when a student leaves the college or cancels the admission.

3. After cancellation of Admission, the fees will be refunded as per guidelines and rules.

4. Above- mentioned deposits if not claimed within one year from the date of leaving the college or cancellation of admission, will be forfeited.

Attendance Requirement:

A Student must attend minimum 75% of lectures, practical and tutorials in each of academic year, failing which he/she will not be allowed to appear for annual examination.

Examination Scheme:

According to the rules laid down by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (Circular No. SB/BR, High. Sec/Exam./dated 7/3/2007), promotion to Std. XII (S.Y.J.C) will be determined on the basis of the average of the marks obtained in all the examinations of Std. XI (F.Y.J.C) by the student.

1. To pass Std. XI, a student must secure a minimum of 35% marks in each subject.

2. To be promoted to Std. XII, a student will get total of 15 marks as grace in the average marks of all 3 subjects, but not more than 10 marks in one subject.

3. A student failing short by maximum of 3 marks to secure Grade-I with Distinction or Grade-I can be given the same marks for achieving the grade.

The above mentioned rules are not applicable for ex-students.

Documents to be submitted by the students:

1. Provisional Eligibility:

A student from another University or Board or Secondary or Intermediate Educational or any other statutory examining body, seeking admission to this University / College shall apply to the Registrar, University of Mumbai for a statement of Eligibility. Such student will not be admitted to any class, if they do not obtain the Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the Registrar, University of Mumbai.

After being admitted to the College on the basis of the Provisional Eligibility Certificate, the student has to obtain final confirmation and eligibility for which he / she will be required to submit the following certificate in original along with attested Xerox copies.

Original Mark Sheet

Original Passing Certificate

Original Migration Certificate

Students admitted on Provisional Basis should note that, if the Registrar of the University of Mumbai does not finally confirm their admissions, their terms will be treated "Null and Void" and they will not be allowed to appear for the final examination of the University of Mumbai.

2. Caste Certificate for Validation:

It is applicable only to students belonging to SC/ST/VJ/NT/OBC/SBC/Nava Buddha who wish to take admission in Professional Colleges after passing the HSC Board Examination. For the validation of above certificates, the student has to submit Original Caste Certificate along with two attested Xerox copies and a copy of Caste Certificate of any of his / her close relative and attested Xerox copy of first and last page of Ration Card on or before $15^{\rm th}$ October every year.

3. Migration Certificate:

When a student of University of Mumbai, either enrolled in an Affiliated College or registered with the University of Mumbai, wishes to leave the University to join any other University / Board for pursuing any course of study, he / she has to obtain a Migration Certificate from this University. A student is required to apply in the prescribed form for the Migration Certificate to the Registrar of the University through the principal of the College / Institution last attended by him / her.

The application for Migration Certificate has to be accompanied by the Transfer Certificate in original and attested Xerox copy of the same.

A duplicate of Migration Certificate will not be issued under any circumstances.

If for any reason the student fails to join the University / Board that he / she had proposed to join, he / she shall return the Migration Certificate issued to him / her within three months from the date of issue of the Migration Certificate for cancellation through the Principal of the College /Institution through which he / she applied for the Migration Certificate.

4. Transfer Certificate:

As per 0.126 no Student shall at any time be admitted to any other College unless he / she produces Transfer Certificate from the College he / she leaves.

The Principal shall be entitled to charge fees of Rs. 100/- for issuing a Transfer Certificate, subject to the provision of ordinance 130, when the Principal receives an application for Transfer Certificate more than one month after the opening of a term. He / She may charge additional fees of Rs. 20/- per term that has lapsed since the applicant attended the College. Provided, however, that the fees charged under the ordinance shall not exceed Rs. 200/- in aggregate.

5. Verification charges for documents is Rs. 500/-



ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS:

Documents issued by the College Office:

1. Bonafide Certificate:

Degree and Junior College students are eligible to get a Bonafide Certificate on application and payment of Rs. 50/- (Rupees Fifty Only)

2. Railway Concession:

Only Bonafide students of the College for the current academic year (male students below 25 years and all girl students) are eligible for Railway concession for the season tickets between the nearest station to residence and Kalyan. The student has to apply in a prescribed form of application available in College Office between 9.30 am and 1.00 pm on working day.

Long Journey Railway concessions are granted only for vacation period according to rules of the Railways for commuting to their native places as shown in their admission forms.

3. Transfer Certificate:

As per the 0.131 If, as a result of a student leaving one College to join other, it will be necessary for him / her to count the attendance kept by him / her in more than one College to enable him / her to make up the necessary number of attendances, a Transfer Certificate shall not be granted except for reasons which appear to the Executive Council to be sufficient and except with the written permission of the Principal of the College which the student wants to leave and the Principal of the College to join another after completion of term, or terms, it will be necessary for him / her to obtain the written permission from the Principal of the College which he / she intend to join.

As per the 0.132 Students shall make application of Transfer Certificate without unnecessary delay through the Principal of the College to which he / she wish to be transferred.

4. Recommendation Letter:

Students applying for Post – Graduate Courses to Indian or Foreign University may apply on a plain paper giving the purpose for which the recommendation letter is sought and other personal and academic details and the name of the faculty from whom such a letter is sought. The Principal on scrutiny of the application will issue relevant instructions to the office to do the needful.

5. College Examination Mark sheets:

The First and Second Year students of Degree College who have appeared for first and second term examinations will be issued the Examination Mark sheets. In the same way the F. Y. Junior College students will be issued the Examination Mark sheets. If student wants a Duplicate Mark sheet, he/she has to apply on plain paper to the Principal of the College and pay Rs. 50/- for the duplicate marksheet.

6. College Leaving Certificate:
